1947

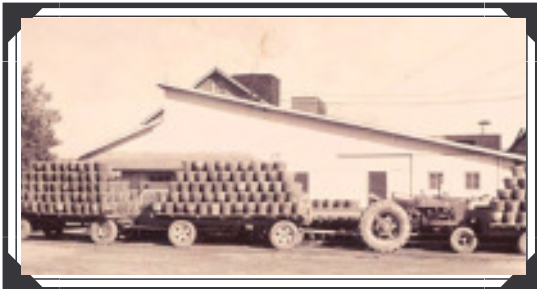
Hirzel Canning Company was Incorporated

1980

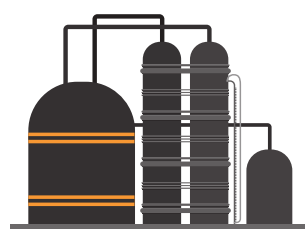
Dei Fratelli is Born.
